Beautiful rooms, great service and a unique location on the water in the centre of Amsterdam: The National Maritime Museum offers a stunning setting for business and social events. This magnificent venue was built during the Dutch Golden Age as a warehouse for the Admiralty of Amsterdam and now, 350 years later, it is a highly popular location for large and small events. To this day, the renovated Arsenal is an impressive symbol of how important the sea and sea trade is for the history of Dutch culture.



Spectacular glass roof

The amazing Open Pleyn, the large interior courtyard of The National Maritime Museum with its spectacular glass roof, is available year-round and every evening for high profile events, unique dinners and unforgettable receptions. The more than 800 LED lights in the roof make it possible to create any atmosphere you might wish. The Open Pleyn Courtyard can accommodate dinners of up to 700 guests and receptions of up to 1,000 guests.

Event rooms with a waterside view

For smaller meetings, The National Maritime Museum can offer three splendid, inspiring event rooms, named after the Dutch naval heroes Tromp, De Ruyter, and Van Heemskerck. These historic, high-ceilinged rooms have a projector, a screen and free wi-fi; and they are perfectly suited as a location for an innovative meeting,

seminar or presentation. The event rooms can be used individually or in conjunction with each other; and because of their beautiful ambiance, they are also outstanding rooms for stylish receptions, dinners and weddings. The capacity of each room is different, ranging from 75 to 120 guests for a meeting to a maximum of 175 guests for a reception.

Intimate dinners

The Admiralty Boardroom is rightfully considered the most captivating room in The National Maritime Museum. Historically, this was the room where the Lords of the Admiralty, responsible for the supervision of the warehouse and the neighbouring shipyard, would hold meetings; the room has now been given contemporary decor while still maintaining its historic feel. The Admiralty Boardroom is a beautiful room, perfectly suited for intimate dinners of up to 30 guests.



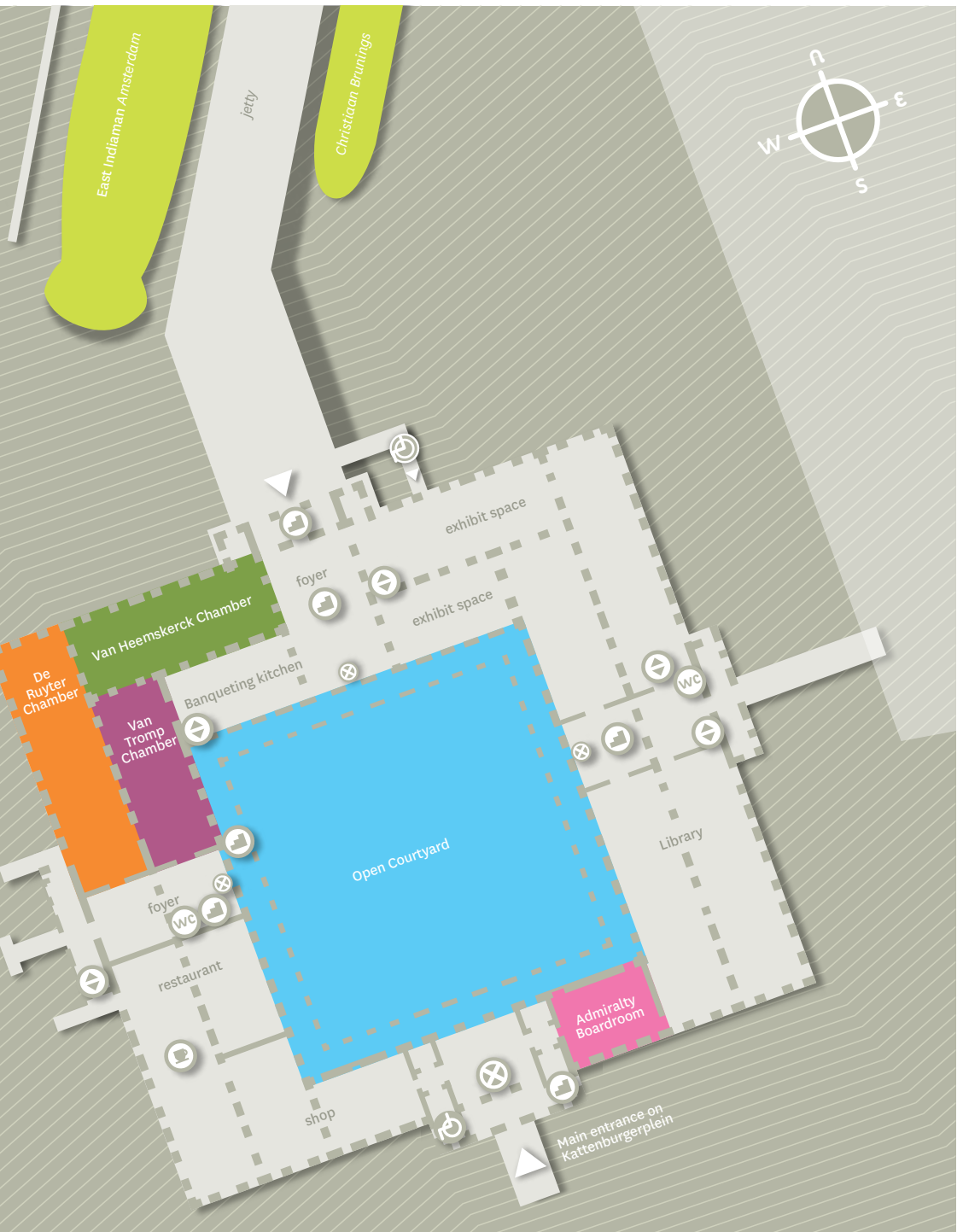
Wedding celebrations
