Rode Hoed

From board meetings to romantic weddings; seven different rooms; a spacious foyer; a beautiful café, and perfectly accessible on foot, by bicycle, car or boat: with a capacity of 450 people and combined with our own professional catering department and very experienced technicians, the Rode Hoed is the full-service events venue in Amsterdam.

Uniquely located on the Keizersgracht in the heart of our capital, Holland's largest clandestine church lies hidden behind the façades of three stately and age-old canal houses. This clandestine church, better known as the Oosterhuiszaal makes the Rode Hoed the ideal location for conferences, concerts, symposia, meetings, (wedding) receptions and dinner parties. The Rode Hoed is frequently used as the setting for television programs and it is one of the most high profile debating centres in Holland.





Room overview



OOSTERHUISZAAL

The former clandestine church is the biggest room of the Rode Hoed. Renowned for the recording of well-known Dutch television programs.

Maximum capacity: 450 guests



VRIJBURGZAAL

This spacious room has a foldable grandstand and a magnificently decorated set of windows. It is especially suitable for small theatre productions, presentations or concerts.

Maximum capacity: 50 guests



ZWANENZAAL

This beautiful 17th century period room with authentic armoires and stairs. It lends itself well for meetings, press conferences or a private dinner party with a small group.

Maximum capacity: 50 guests



GROENZAAL

This attractive en suite room, with authentic rococo style elements, is the perfect accommodation for meetings, intimate drinks parties and workshops.

Maximum capacity: 20 guests



BANNINGZAAL

The Banningzaal is very suitable for drinks parties, lunches and can also be used, in combination with the Vrijburgzaal, as a lobby.



AMSTERDAMZAAL

This very special en suite room on the first floor is the perfect location for smaller meetings and intimate dinner parties.



FOYER EN CAFE

The interior design is a mixture of modern elements and the classic harmony of the Oosterhuiszaal.

ARCHITECTENZAAL

The Architectenzaal is situated a bit further, on the Keizersgracht 126, and is for hire in combination with one of the other rooms in the Rode Hoed.

Services



Oosterhuiszaal

Built in the seventeenth century, the former clandestine church is the largest in its kind. Its unique location, exclusive ambiance and capacity, combined with the other the Rode Hoed rooms, makes the Oosterhuiszaal a fabulous place for conferences, concerts, lectures, receptions, weddings, and dinner parties.

Unique assets of the Oosterhuiszaal are its two balconies with a magnificent view of the stage. The original pulpit and the restored organ lend its characteristic atmosphere to this room. Grand, sophisticated, yet with intimacy, the room keeps its pleasant atmosphere with 50, as well as with 450 guests. The vaulted ceilings account for the outstanding acoustics.

This room, named after the founder of the Rode Hoed Foundation, Mr Huub Oosterhuis, is renowned for the recording of well-known Dutch television programs, societal and political debates, and award ceremonies.

Maximum capacity: 450 guests





Until 1629, a hat maker was established behind the Keizersgracht 102-106 premises. A plaque with a little red hat on the façade of number 104 is all that is left of the craft that lent its name to the Rode Hoed. In 1630, a real church was built on the base of the hattery. The church has been used by the Remonstrants until 1957. On 14 September 1990, the Rode Hoed was officially opened as a debating house. Since 2010, the ring of canals, within which the Rode Hoed is located, has been inscribed in the UNESCO World Heritage List.

The characteristic organ in the Oosterhuiszaal dates from 1719 and is built by the German Thomas Weidtmann. In 1862, the complete organ had been restored, but it gradually became dilapidated. Since the latest restoration in 2009, however, the organ is in great condition and is played during the regular Clandestine Church Sunday Afternoon Concert Series.



Conferences

The Rode Hoed makes an excellent conference venue. The Oosterhuiszaal has a capacity of 450 people and is also suitable for smaller parties. Additionally, six smaller rooms, as well as the foyer and café, can be used as extra rooms for workshops.

The Rode Hoed 's central location, near Amsterdam Central Station, makes it easily accessible on foot, and there are several parking garages within walking distance. The mooring at the doorstep on the Keizersgracht offers excellent possibilities to combine a conference in the Rode Hoed with a canal trip through Amsterdam's historic heart.



You can enjoy a dinner party according to your every wish: from a so-called walking dinner with finger food, to a richly and exquisitely decked buffet or a sit-down dinner.

Beautifully adorned dishes will be served at table by our waiting staff, who are happy to advise you about good wines to accompany. The Rode Hoed has contacts with various wine houses in the Netherlands, so we will always find the appropriate wine for any occasion. In our professional kitchens our chefs prepare dishes from all cuisines of the world. We prefer seasonal fresh and organic products and, according to your personal wishes, we will put together a menu.

The Rode Hoed possesses a wide-ranged network of speakers and musicians. If you would like to offer your guests a tasteful dinner and complete the evening with a motivating speech, an interesting lecture or a beautiful classical chamber concert, the Rode Hoed can help you organising it.









Meetings

The Rode Hoed has seven different rooms where you can gather for your meetings in quiet. You may choose for a short assembly in the morning, or a combination of a meeting with a copious lunch or drinks party.

You will receive your guests in one of the rooms of the Rode Hoed with coffee, tea, soft drinks and petits fours. During the break, hot and cold beverages will be replenished. A copious lunch will be served: for instance, a home-made pumpkin soup, a mozzarella salad with sun dried tomato, or an Indian flavoured chicken ciabatta with avocado; all dishes accompanied with fresh fruit juices, dairy products, coffee and tea.

Drinks parties

After a meeting, conference or debate you might want to look back upon the day with your guests, while enjoying drinks and refreshments.

In our stylish café, with a beautiful view on the Keizersgracht, and adjoining foyer, we serve a wide variety of refreshments and beverages, which makes the Rode Hoed highly suitable for graduation parties, networking events or New Year's parties.
