The long, rich history of Het West-Indisch Huis, located in the center from Amsterdam started in 1617. Until 1623 the ground floor was used as meat market, with the rooms above it in front "De Schutterij", who watched over the safety of Amsterdam.

Het West-Indisch Huis owes its name to the period between 1623 and 1647, when the "Gentlemen Nineteen" held sway from here about the Dutch 'West India Company'.

The decision is in the Company Room made around the Fort "New Amsterdam" on the island of Manhattan.



THE LOCATION WHERE HISTORY IS WRITTEN

The privateering of Spanish ships, carried out commissioned by the West India Company, collected a large loot in the same period.

The biggest blow was the capture of one fully loaded silver fleet by Admiral Piet Heijn. These treasures were stored in the basement of the West Indies House, nowadays the Piet Heijn Cellar.

Het West-Indisch Huis is a historic place in the heart of Amsterdam where people meet, work, relax and experience beautiful moments. Het West-Indisch Huis has a beautiful courtyard, the hidden gem in Amsterdam, where you will experience an oasis of tranquility.
