Art Zoo Museum is an artistic tribute to the animal kingdom and nature, housed in one of Amsterdam's most beautiful 17th-century canal houses. In this oasis in the heart of the city, you gaze from enormous aviaries into a world where animals reign supreme. The breathtaking taxidermy art of Darwin, Sinke & Van Tongeren fills the spaces. From colourful birds and winding snakes to imposing crocodiles and a T. rex – it's as if they could spring to life at any moment.

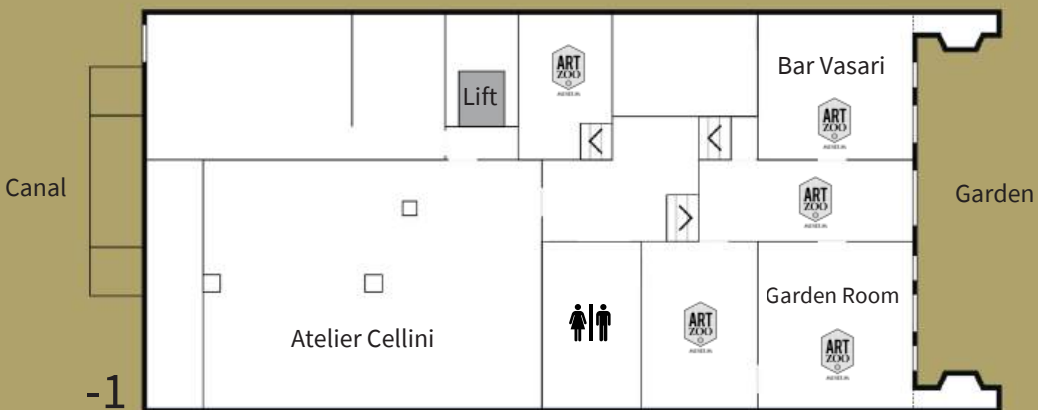
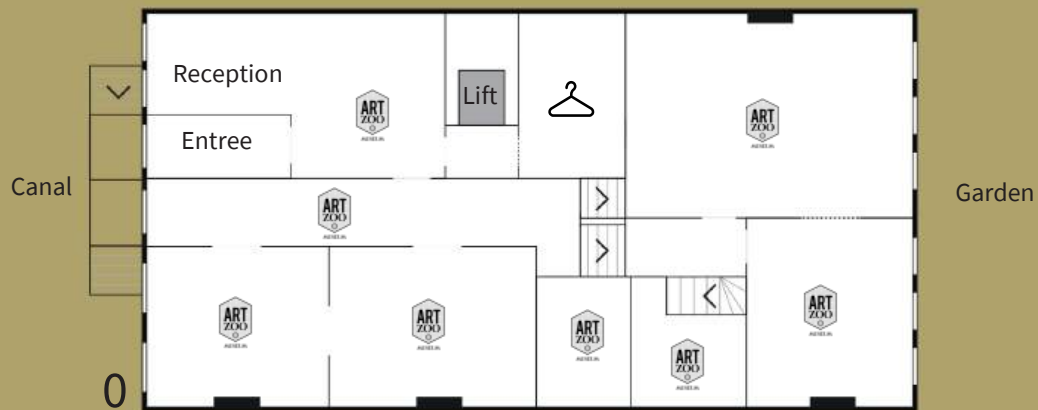
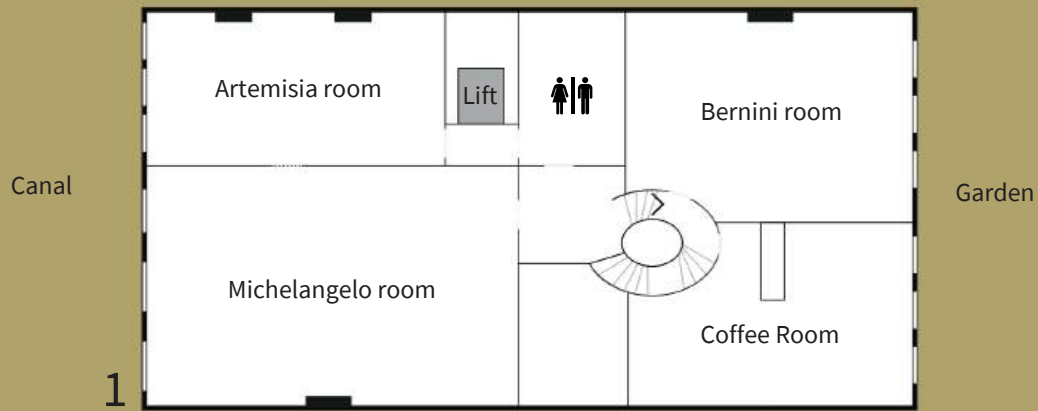

Floor Plan & Capacity

Art Zoo Museum offers a variety of rooms, a workshop studio, Bar Vasari, and several small breakout spaces suitable for groups ranging from 4 to 120 guests. All larger rooms come equipped with standard theatre seating and audiovisual equipment, and can be rearranged to suit your event requirements. An unattended cloakroom is available.

For exclusive events, the entire venue can be hired with a maximum capacity of 500 guests.

Please note: due to the building's historic character, it is not fully wheelchair accessible.

The rooms can be arranged in various layouts upon request, including classroom, U-shape, boardroom, banquet, or reception configurations:





Michelangelo Room

The largest room in the building. The Michelangelo Room is flooded with natural light, creating a spacious and airy atmosphere. This versatile space is ideal for corporate receptions, conferences, lectures, presentations, or walking dinners.

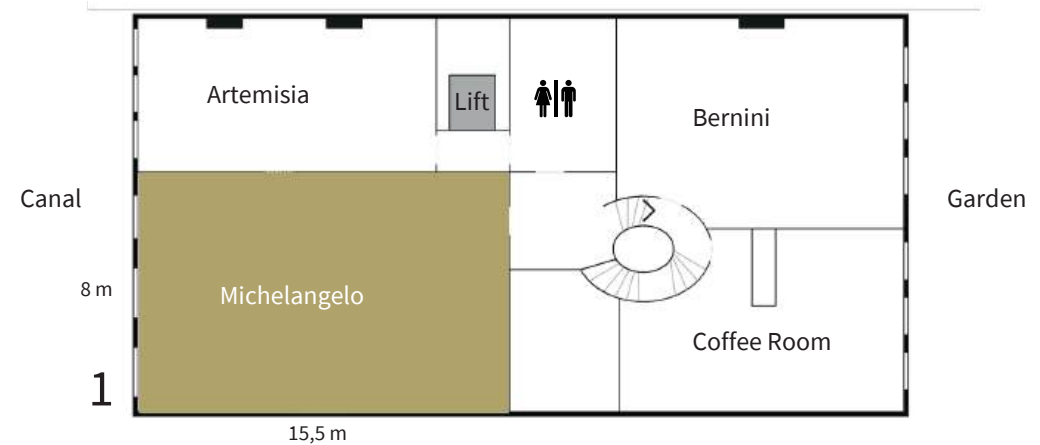

Artemisia Room

The smallest lecture room in the building, the Artemisia Room is set up in a standard classroom layout for 25 guests, making it ideal for focused meetings and workshops. For larger gatherings, a theatre-style layout can accommodate up to 50 guests.

The room connects seamlessly to the adjacent Michelangelo Room via an interconnecting door, offering flexibility for larger events. On the same floor, a dedicated coffee room provides the perfect setting for breaks, drinks, or buffet service. The Artemisia Room is equipped with a projector and screen for presentations.

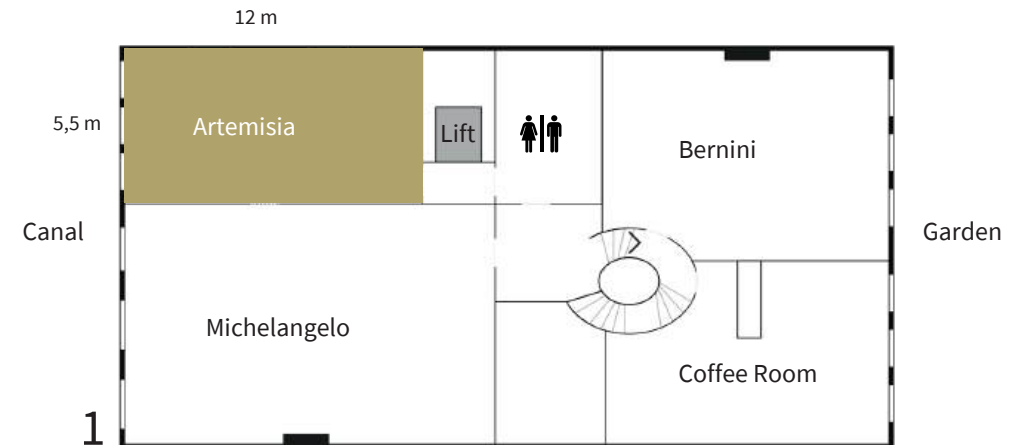

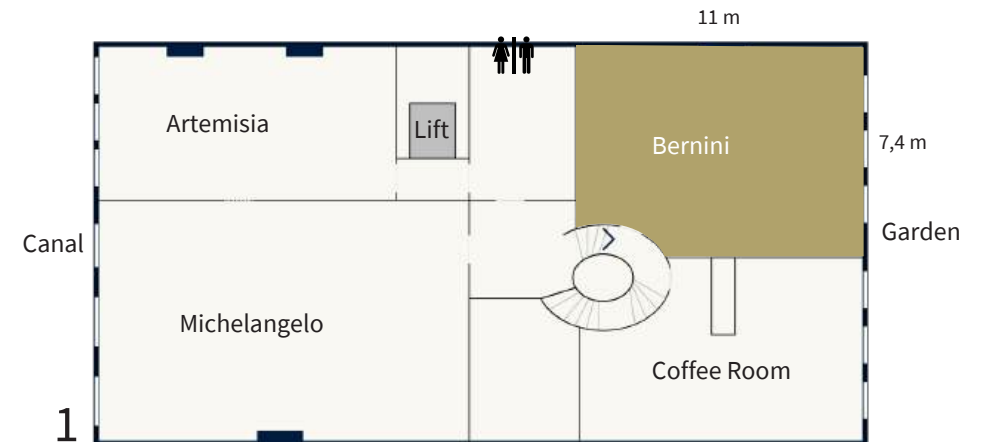

Coffee Room

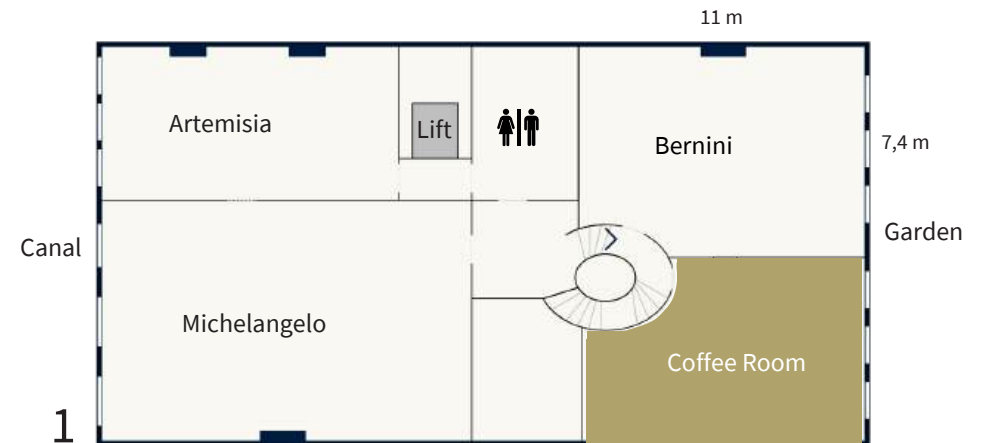

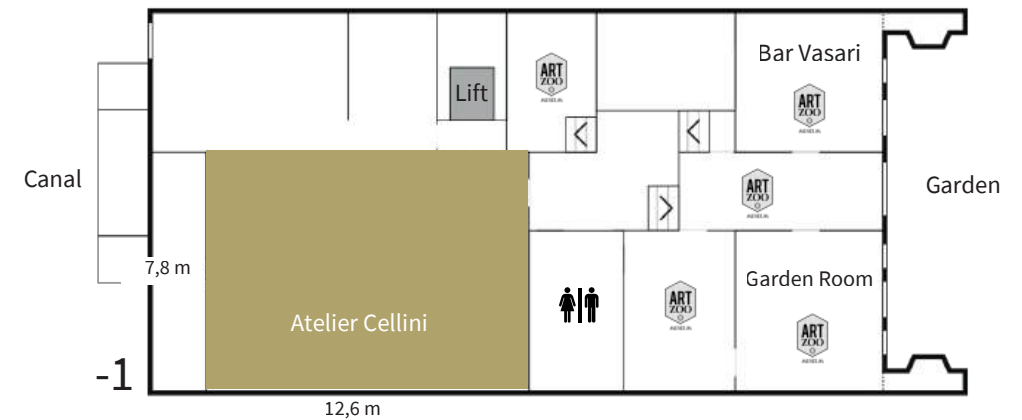
